My car is a 1993 Mustang LX that I purchased in 2016. It was originally owned by Kevin Toothman, Fun Ford Weekend Street Bandit Racer. Back then, the car had a 399ci N/A motor.

Unfortunately, a month after I purchased the car from Kevin, my dad passed away. He never got to see the car and watch me race in it.

Now I currently have the car set up for X275 with 2-stage Proflow Nitrous system and Edelbrock Nitrous Progression system, MSD digital plus 7531 box. However, due to limited funds and lack of crew, I'm only running on motor and only bracket race.

- Seizure or coma
- Nausea and vomiting

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO...

- Notfiy someone immediately that you're not feeling well
- Call 9-1-1
- Take action immediately to cool yourself while waiting for emergency treatment
- Get yourself indoor or into shade
- Remove excess clothing—hat, socks, shoes, gloves, etc
- Cool yourself down with whatever means possible—pour water over head, spray with garden hose, place ice packs on yourself or wet towels on the head, neck, armpits and groin

# Please register on the website if you plan to attend so we can plan enough food.




We also still need volunteers to help serve the food and cook. So if you would like to help in any capacity, please let me know.

SAMC linked together with the Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) in the Houston, TX area to make them a sister club. Below is information about NMCC, submitted to us by their President, Randy Weldon. A Calendar of their planned events will follow on the next page. Everyone is welcome to participate in their activities, and SAMC will make every effort to list them on our Calendar as well.

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating 1 of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

From inception, NMCC has been sponsored by Gullo Ford of Conroe/ The Woodlands whose charity, Gullo Christmas for Kids, ensures children always have a Christmas and is supported by our club as is Honor Flight Houston which flies Veterans back to Washington DC to see War Memorials either for their 1<sup>st</sup> or potentially last time.

Each year NMCC holds 2 major car shows, one in the April/May timeframe (Gullo's All Ford Show to support Gullo Christmas for Kids) and one in October, the "Camaro vs Mustang Faceoff" to support Honor Flight Houston. (The HTown Camaro Club supports their charity during this event, The 100 Club for families of fallen I<sup>st</sup> responders.)
