Dick's Classic Car Garage Closes its Doors to Become an Education Foundation for Charities, Grants, and Scholarships

Back when I first joined SAMC, the club took a cruise together to Dick's Classic Car Garage for a car show outside, museum tour inside and dinner with a movie hosted in the museum's party room. I had never heard of or been to Dick's, and having the passion for seeing classic cars, I joined my fellow SAMC club members for this group excursion. Little did I know what I was in for... I paid my ticket for entry into the museum, walked inside and my eyes grew as wide as a child's on Christmas Day looking at all the presents from Santa under the tree. I saw a life-size replica of the Batman car used in the TV show back in the 60's!! As I walked around the corner into the exhibit, I saw rows and rows of history parked and shining ever so brightly. It was an experience to remember, and since my dad's name is Dick, I bought a couple of T-shirts. When I heard the news about Dick's Classic Car Garage closing its doors, I was sad because it meant that a great place for a family outing and facility to spark an interest for cars in the minds of young children was seeing the end of its days. Dick's Classic Car Garage was founded in 2009 and served to excite visitors while educating them about the impact and evolution of the automobile since 1901. We have until December 30th, 2018 to visit the museum because on December 31st the Dick's Classic Car Garage will close its doors forever. All the cars and memorabilia will be sold at RM Sotheby's auctions in 2019. Proceeds from the sales will go to fund the Richard L. Burdick Foundation, an education foundation created to award charities and individuals with scholarships and grants. After December 31st, six of the museum's cars will be on display starting on February 15th at the McNay Art Museum in San Antonio, TX for their exhibit called "American Dreams: Classic Cars and Postwar Paintings" The exhibit will run through May 15, 2019. Afterward, those six cars will also be sold at auction. If you haven't seen it, go visit Dick's Classic Car Garage before the doors close forever... ~Becky Dowda

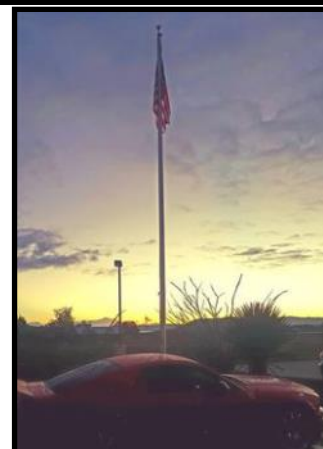
Twisted Fillies Wine Cruise

Northside Mustang Car Club

SAMC linked together with the Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) in the Houston, TX area to make them a sister club. Below is information about NMCC, submitted to us by their President, Randy Weldon. A Calendar of their planned events will follow on the next page. Everyone is welcome to participate in their activities, and SAMC will make every effort to list them on our Calendar as well.

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating 1 of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

From inception, NMCC has been sponsored by Gullo Ford of Conroe/ The Woodlands whose charity, Gullo Christmas for Kids, ensures children always have a Christmas and is supported by our club as is Honor Flight Houston which flies Veterans back to Washington DC to see War Memorials either for their 1st or potentially last time.

Each year NMCC holds 2 major car shows, one in the April/May timeframe (Gullo's All Ford Show to support Gullo Christmas for Kids) and one in October, the "Camaro vs Mustang Faceoff" to support Honor Flight Houston. (The HTown Camaro Club supports their charity during this event, The 100 Club for families of fallen 1st responders.)

NMCC also holds an annual Austin Overnight Cruise in June to grab a bite to eat overlooking Lake Travis and drive through the Hill Country, later relaxing and telling stories around the hotel pool.

Recently working in conjunction with the HTown Camaro Club we started what is believed will become an annual event, the "Camaro vs Mustang Bragging Rights Drag Racing Event."

NMCC also holds a monthly Cruise-In for Charity Event called TWCC, monthly dinners the 3rd Thursday of each month and a monthly Cruise-In for Fun event, the JCI Street Meet.

As NMCC has grown, we've focused on areas of club Members' passion and created "committees" for each area of passion. As an example, we created an Open Road Course Track Committee and now have members for an Open Course Track Team. The same is true for the Autocross (AutoX) Committee, Drag Racing Committee, Membership Committee, Car Show Committee, Family Events Committee, Cruise Committee and the OMR (Old Mustangs Rule) Committee who were originally called the OGR (Old Guys Rule) Committee until one of the guys objected to being called old....

Thru the creation of committees NMCC has become very active. On any given weekend it's now not unusual for NMCC to be taking part in 5 or more events in or around the city of Houston.

NMCC works very hard on 2 issues as a major focus: 1.) No Cliques; and 2.) No Drama. All of us got involved in our local club to have Fun. We're fortunate enough to have a Board of Directors who works well together and is very committed to working hard for the club. We're well aware that there is no club without our Members and our Members are here to have FUN.

Over the past year as the committee's have taken off, we've developed a slogan that we live, "Get Off the Couch with That Little Ol' Club from Texas, NMCC!"

We look forward to working closely to support SAMC and encourage any

SAMC Member finding themselves in the Houston area to come out & play with us.

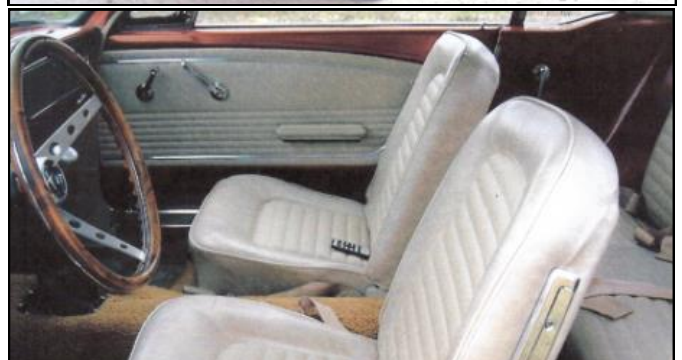
