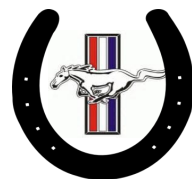

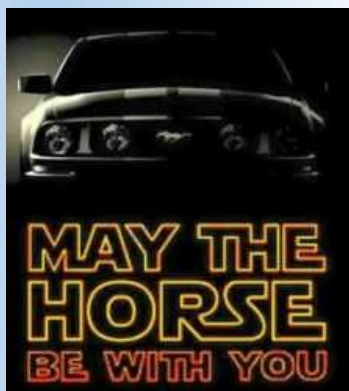

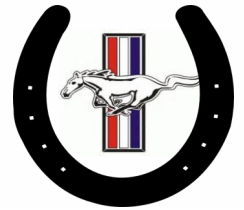

**San Antonio Mustang Club****Newsletter Statement of Purpose**

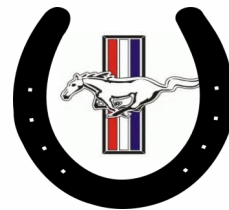

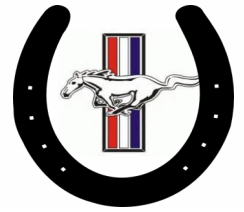


### SAMC CLUB CHARITY:
